- Signed legislation into law requiring that women considering abortions be given the opportunity to see an ultrasound image and to hear the baby's heartbeat.
- Signed legislation into law banning any attempts to clone human beings.
- Ended 25 years of Indiana abortion clinics operating without any licensure or inspection by signing tough new inspection standards into law.
- The BMV under his administration approved Indiana's: "Choose Life" specialty license plate.
- Supports abstinence-focused education in Indiana's public schools.
- Supports giving pharmacists the right to refuse filling prescriptions for abortion causing drugs.
- Supports requiring that abortionists tell women seeking abortion about the unborn child's ability to feel pain.
- Voted for taxpayer funding for the U.N. Population Control Fund, even in countries like China that practice coercive abortion policies.
- Voted against legislation requiring that abortion clinics give parents at least 48 hours' notice before a minor's abortion.
- Voted to allow non-physician abortion counseling at taxpayer funded abortion clinics.
- Voted for allowing the National Institute of Health to use tissue from intentionally aborted children for research.
- Voted to make abortions available for the full nine months of pregnancy in U.S. overseas military hospitals.
- Supports Roe vs. Wade, the U.S. Supreme Court ruling that legalizes abortion on demand for the full nine months of pregnancy.
- Voted for taxpayer funded abortions.
